1 RULES

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2009-2012 of The Racing Rules of Sailing
- 1.2** No National Authority Prescriptions will apply
- 1.3** International J24 Class Rules which can be seen and downloaded from www.j24class.org will apply
- 1.4** Under rules 87, rule(s) 5.3 of the J24 class rules is changed as follows: Crew substitution is allowed. Other changes may appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1** The regatta is open to boats of the J24 class that are currently registered with the International Class of Ireland.
- 3.2** Boat Registration Forms and Individual Membership Forms will be available at the Regatta Race Office from Friday 6th August 2010. Eligible boats may enter by completing the event entry form and paying the required entry fee, to Hon Secretary, Lough Erne Yacht Club, Gublusk, Ballinamallard, Co Fermanagh, BT94 2LW at the regatta office on Friday evening 6th August 2010 6-9pm.
- 3.3** Transom decals, Class membership cards, and 2009-2012 Class rule books will be available at registration.

4 Fees

4.1 Required fees are as follows

Class Registration: £/€50

Event Entry: €50 or £40

Individual Membership: €/\$10 (where applicable)

Note: The event entry fee includes all craneage costs and marina fees for the duration of the event.

5 Schedule

5.1 Registration facilities will be available from 6-9pm at the Regatta Race Office on Friday 6th August 2010

5.2 Crane facilities will be available from 3-9pm on Friday 6th August

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The sailing instructions will be available from the Regatta Office at registration.

7 THE COURSES

7.1 The courses to be sailed will be as listed in the sailing instructions.

8 SCORING

8.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A, will apply

8.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series

8.2.1 When fewer than four races have been sailed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores

- 8.2.2** When from four to six races have been completed, a boats' series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score;

9 BERTHING

- 9.1** Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the harbour marina

10 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

- 10.1** Boats shall not be hauled-out during the regatta, except with and according to the terms of written permission of the race committee;

11 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

- 11.1** Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor receive radio communication not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones;

12 PRIZES

- 12.1** The International J24 Class of Ireland will provide First & Second place Perpetual Trophies for both the Gold and Silver (Westerly) Fleet

13 CATERING

- 13.1** The Championship Dinner will be held in the Clubhouse at 7.30pm on Saturday 7th August. The cost of the dinner will be €20.00 or £15.00. Menu enclosed.
