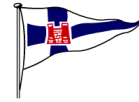

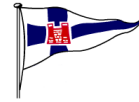
Marina Berths at Lough Erne Yacht Club

The Marina is there to accommodate members who participate in the activities of the club and who have a keen interest in yachting in particular and boating in general.

Criteria for Marina Berth Allocation

1. The applicant must have been a club member for a minimum of three years.
2. Preference will be given to those who
 - a. are existing berth holders
 - b. have contributed to the organisation and management of the club during their period of membership.
3. The Management Committee may take personal circumstances into account.
4. A person wishing to apply for a marina berth at LEYC, must make a written application to the Management Committee each year..
5. The waiting list applies only to the year of application, but the Management Committee may take previous unsuccessful applications into account.
6. Boats in excess of 12m length, 4.5m beam and 12 tonnes weight will **NOT** be accommodated unless special consideration is given by the management committee.

Protocol for Allocation of Marina Berths

1. The management committee is the sole authority in respect of marina berth allocation and the management thereof.
2. A member must apply in writing each year to the Hon. Secretary to be considered for an annual licence to occupy a marina berth.
3. If a vacancy arises the Management Committee will consider all applicants in the current year using the criteria set out above.
4. When a berth holder decides to end his/her occupation of a berth, he/she must notify the Hon. Secretary in writing.
5. When relinquishing a berth, the owner must remove the boat from the berth by the end of the leasing period for which they have paid.
