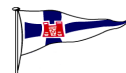

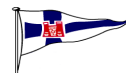

The Process of Membership

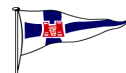
- 1 Membership is based on Application form and the proposer & seconders references. In order to determine willingness to donate time and expertise to club activities, an interview may take place.
- 2 Applicants not known to club members, should contact the Secretary;
- 3 Membership is totally at the discretion of the management committee, may be refused or withdrawn without right to appeal;
- 4 On receipt of the application form by the management committee your proposer will be contacted for references;
- 5 An interview will follow at a mutually agreed time;
- 6 You will be notified of the outcome in writing.

Data Protection

- 1 Your information will be secured and stored off-line for the purposes of administering your membership and official communications between you and the club;
- 2 Should any of your contact, family, boat or other details relevant to your membership change, please contact the club secretary at info@leyc.net at the earliest opportunity. Changes will be effected as soon as possible;
- 3 Your details will not be sold/distributed to an external agency;
- 4 The club communicates mainly by email. Should you wish to be contacted by other means, please contact the secretary.

Classes of Membership

- Adult** Any person aged 18 or over on 31 December of the following year. Adult members have a vote at General Meetings of the Company.
- Family** 'Family' includes two adults living at the same address as a family unit, with or without children. The individuals within the family shall be accepted into the categories appropriate to their ages. The term 'children' refers to those under 21 years or if in full-time education those less than 24 years on 31 December of the following year. The adult members shall each have one vote at General Meetings.
- Outport** Outport members are former members of the club or persons who desire to have an association with the club but who do not propose to participate other than occasionally in the activities of the club. Outport members will not have a vote at General Meetings of the Company
- Cadet** Any young person between over 10 and under 18 years on 31st December of the following year. Cadet members are subject to the same application procedures as Adult members. In addition, application should be supported and authorised by a parent or guardian. Cadet members have the right to speak at General Meetings of the Company but are not entitled to vote.

Other classes membership are: Junior Members, Life Members, Honorary Members and Temporary Members for which this Application Form is not appropriate. If you wish to receive full details of all forms of memberships, please contact the Club Secretary.
